## **Abstract Content (EN)**

The inter-committee panel - COWAP and the Committee for the Study of Sexual and Gender Diversity- will discuss reflections on Gender, Sexuality and Freedom to further deepen the psychoanalytic point of view. Patricia Alkolombre will discuss clinical scenarios linking gender, desire and freedom in contemporary parenthood. In particular, she will focus on the desire for a child and the current scenarios that propose a de-gendering, a liberation from the traditional modalities in this field that have been attributed to genders since the use of biotechnology. Clinical vignettes will be presented. Leticia Glocer Fiorini will address the expansions and limits of subjective freedom in the domains of sexuality and gender both in the field of sexual and gender diversities and the female condition. This approach will focus on the different theoretical, clinical, discursive and cultural variables. Emphasis will be placed on the transference/countertransference of the analyst as well as in the implicit and private theories, beliefs and prejudices of both psychoanalysts and patients. A clinical vignette will be presented.
